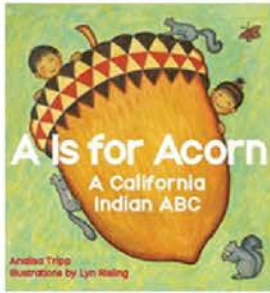
EARTH PIGMENT PAINTING

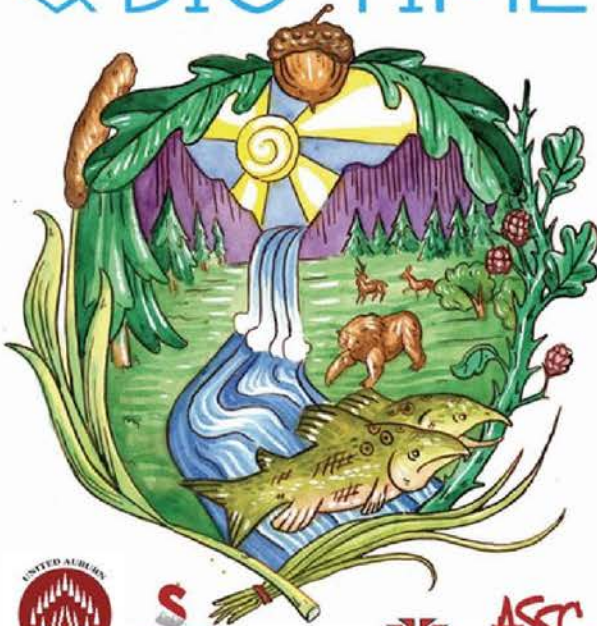
